

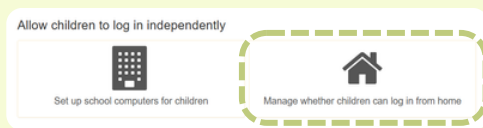
# Setting up Child Login to be used at home

For children to use the Child Login page at home via **Method 1**, they will need to be attached to a live relative account on your Tapestry package. This is because the relative account is used to give the child access to Tapestry remotely.

## Via the Relative Account

### METHOD 1

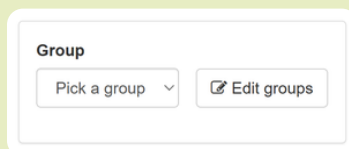
Start on the Child Login page in Tapestry and click the 'Manage whether children can log in from home' button.



Select 'Allow children to log in at home'.



Choose a group from the drop down.



Select how children will log in after the relative, then you can choose to set up or keep the children's passwords.



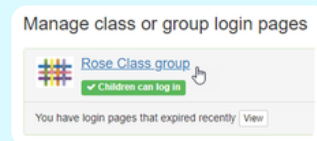
Once the process has been completed, Child Login can be accessed from home through the relative's account. After logging in, the relatives should see the 'Child Login' button in the blue menu on the browser version of Tapestry.



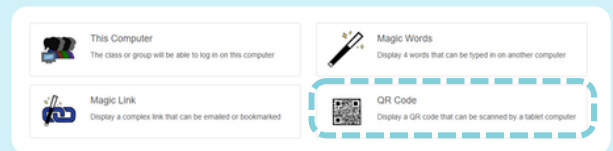
## Using a QR Code

### METHOD 2

Start on the Child Login page in Tapestry and click the group login page that you want to give home access to.



Select the 'QR Code' option near the top of the page.



Select the 'Download PDF' option underneath the QR code.



You can then choose to either print a copy for the children to take home, or you can email the code to their respective relatives.



The children will then be able to use a home device's camera/QR reader app to scan the QR code and it will take them to their group login page.
